Deadlines for Accommodation for Upcoming Standardized Tests

If you plan on taking the PSAT, SAT, ACT, or an AP test this year, and are eligible for accomodations, your parent/guardian must fill out an Accomodation Consent Form for *each* test at least seven weeks in advance. You must also sign up *early* for a testing seat at a local test center, as these seats go fast.
