## **Course Requests due Monday, March 4**

Parents and guardians of 9th-11th Graders are reminded that the deadline to enter course requests for the 2024-2025 school year is this Monday.

Please encourage your student to make sure that they are adding alternate requests for every elective they are requesting. The alternates are used if their first choice class fills up, is canceled, or doesn't fit into their schedule.

Students will soon be receiving communication from their school counselor regarding how to sign up for an academic advising appointment to review their course requests.

#### Reminder: AP Cancellation and Refund Deadline

Fri, Mar 8 is the last date by which a student can receive a partial refund if they cancel their Advanced Placement exams. The cancellation fee is \$40,00 per test, If your child wishes to cancel their Advanced Placement exam, they can so by logging onto their Total Registration account and requesting the cancellation, or by emailing Ms. Ballou.

Each blood donation can save up to three people! Students older than 16 years old can sign up for a donation slot during their free/study blocks, during lunch, or before and after school. If your child is 16, they will need to bring a signed parent permission form to the drive.

March is Red Cross Month, and we hope to help address the national blood shortage and save lives with the first student drive our club has held at LHS! Every student who donates blood will receive an \$10 e-gift card, and will be automatically entered into a raffle to win a \$3,000 gift card—along with stickers, of course!
